

Mark Nayman Timeshare Review: La Vista Beach Resort

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An ocean paradise awaits you at La Vista Beach Resort, which is located on the beach overlooking the crystal blue waters of Lay Bay. Relax in the balmy sea breeze, sunbathe on the beach, snorkel, or cool off in the resort's pool. You can also enjoy breathtaking sunsets from your timeshare balcony as well as the serene sounds of the ocean right at your fingertips. For the adventurous, explore both the Dutch and French sides of the beautiful island. Philipsburg offers first-rate shopping while Marigot offers excellent prices on French goods.

The staff at La Vista is very friendly and helpful. The timeshare resort is small enough that things can be handled pretty efficiently in almost all cases.

One of the entrances to the unit is at the rear of the building, off the parking area down the hill from the office. There are no elevators, and, help is offered to carry luggage to your unit.

The view from the living room is an endless sea of beautiful turquoise, and opening the two big glass doors added the soothing sounds of the surf crashing on the rocks.

The beach in front of La Vista is not really a swimming beach. There is a rocky ledge all along the shore, which creates an area of tidal pools. All day and night the surf comes in over the rocks, providing a wonderful background sound. In the distance, the island of Saba is visible when the weather is clear, and the cruise ships pass by the resort on their way in and out of Phillipsburg. Access to the Simpson Bay Marina was also recently widened to accommodate larger boats, and the array of truly incredible yachts going in and out was pretty awesome. Off to the right is where the sun sets each evening..

The terrace has a table, 4 chairs, and a lounge. The living room/kitchen has a sleeper couch, a chair and coffee table, a dining room table and chairs, TV (with cable), and a VCR. The kitchen area is separated by a breakfast bar type divider with bar stools/chairs.

The kitchen itself was very well equipped, with ample dishes (for 😊 and appliances. There was a blender, a coffee maker (with filters), a toaster, along with a full size stove and oven, and a full size refrigerator. There was a full supply of knives and pots and pans.

The 2BR units are laid out with both bedrooms at the rear of the unit. The master bedroom has a private bath and the smaller bedroom has a bathroom with two entries, providing private access to someone sleeping in the living room. Actually, the master bedroom is configured such that it can be locked off as a hotel room.

The bathrooms are ample size, with double sinks, built-in hair dryers, and showers (no tubs). A supply of soap, shampoo, and lotion are supplied. There is an ample closet in the hallway area, which also houses a safe. The entire unit is air-conditioned, ..
